...but


- Let us not forget about our overarching system of public procurement rules and principles, and

On the financial burden borne by SMEs

Payment delays by public agencies contribute to SMEs' financial distress...







An idea tailored on the National Frame Contracts awarded by Consip

Select a Factor on a competitive basis that replaces the contractor as the public agencies' creditor when the payment delay expires

Pros for SMEs:

- reduction of the factoring cost
- higher attractiveness of the NFC system

Pros for Public Agencies:

- benefit from the factor's invoice-handling system
- higher competition from potentially higher participation
