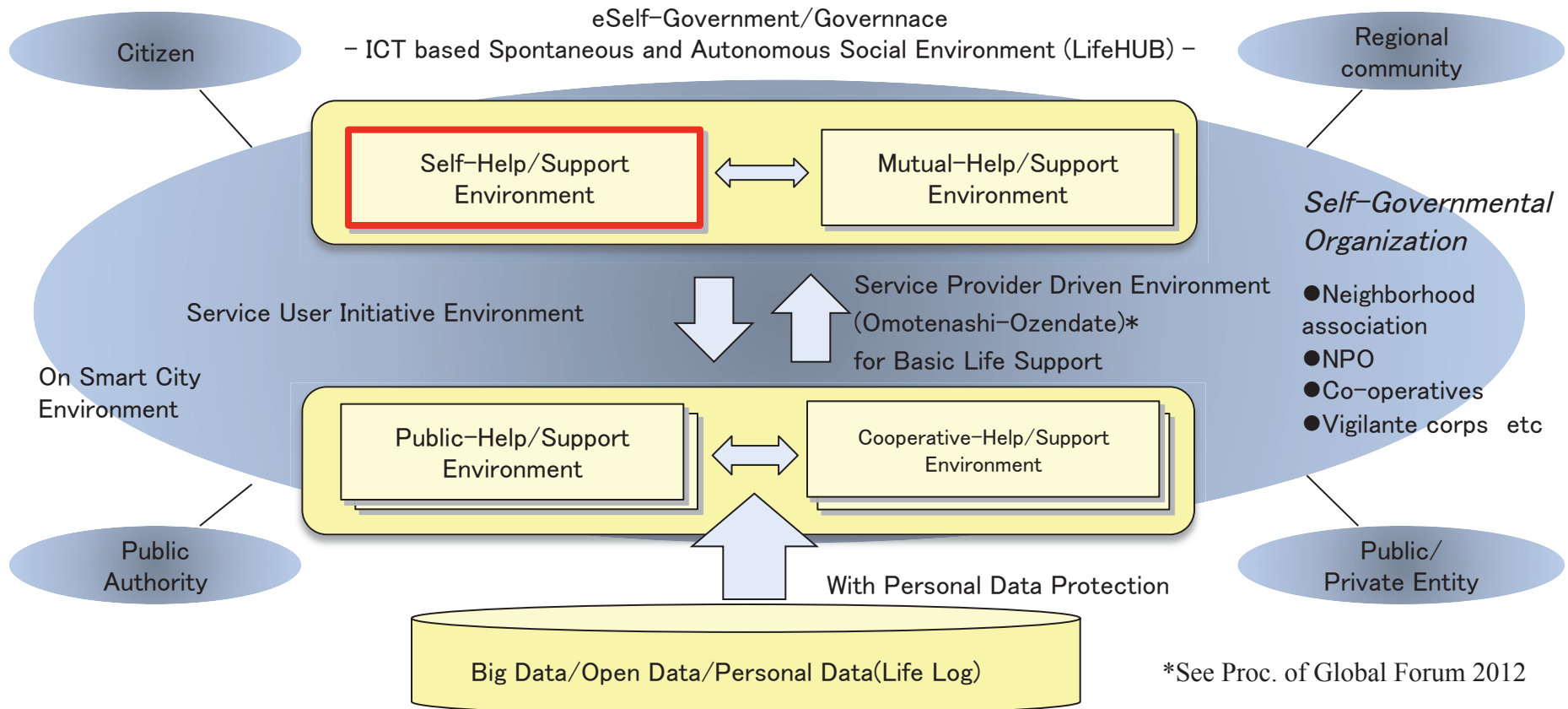
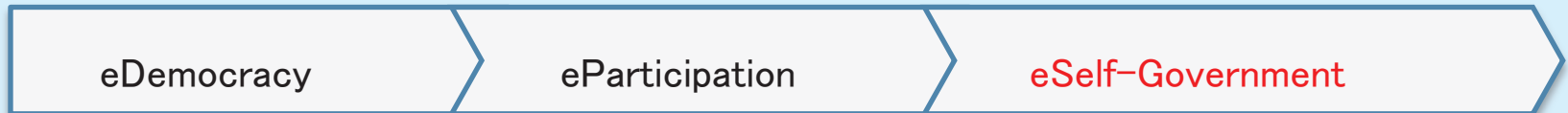
- Citizen has become to join government activities well through ICT such as eDemocracy and eParticipation, then what is next issue?

 - Improvement of social/community/regional computing technology including big data, open data and personal information utilization



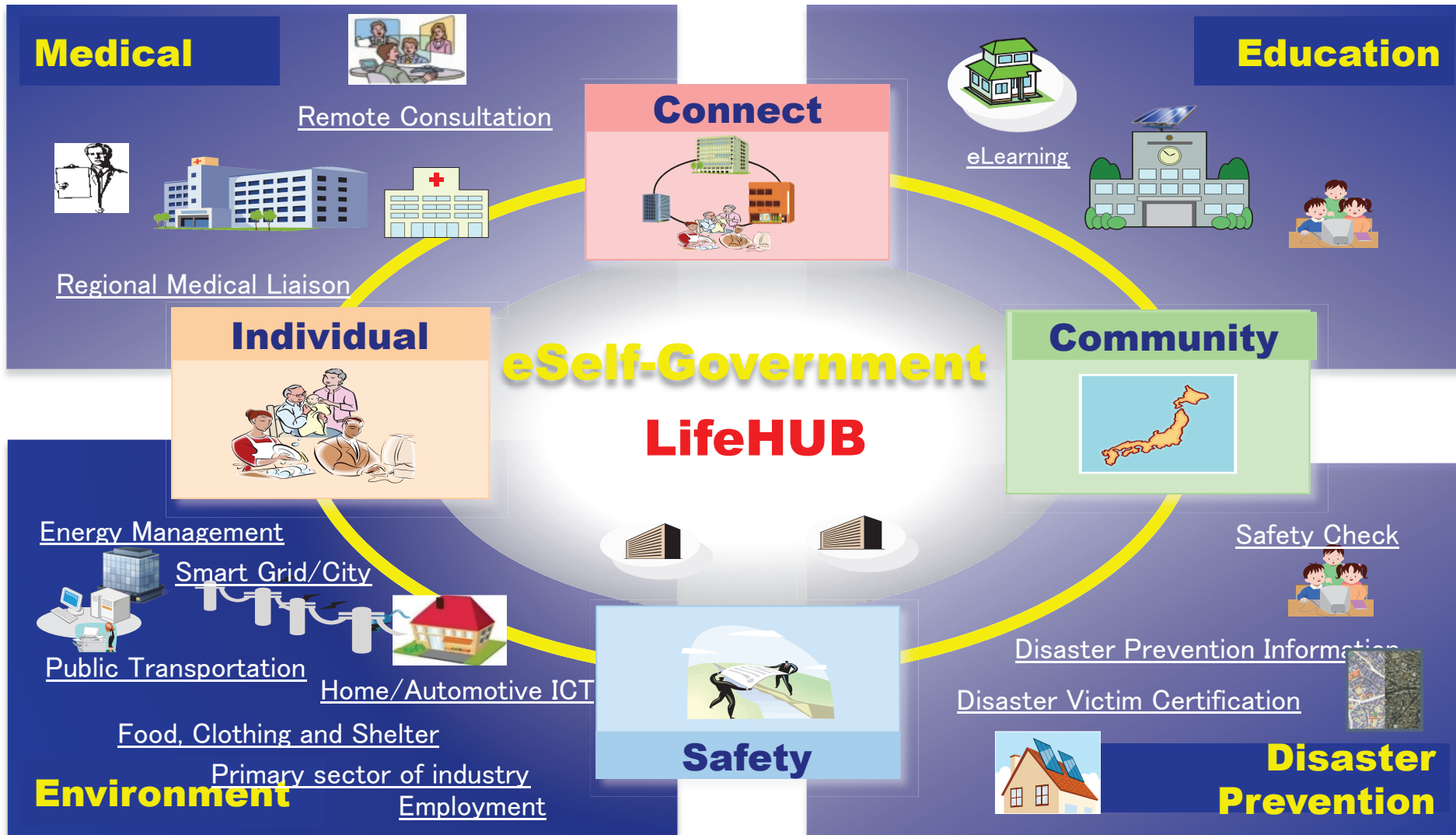
Offer of the ICT based environment which regional entities can administrate themselves and cooperate each other spontaneously and autonomously for their basic life
