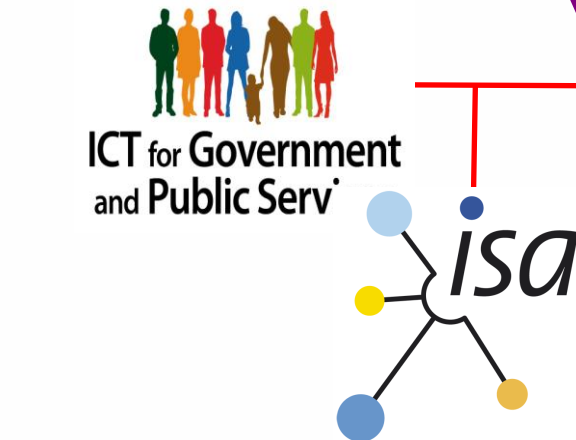

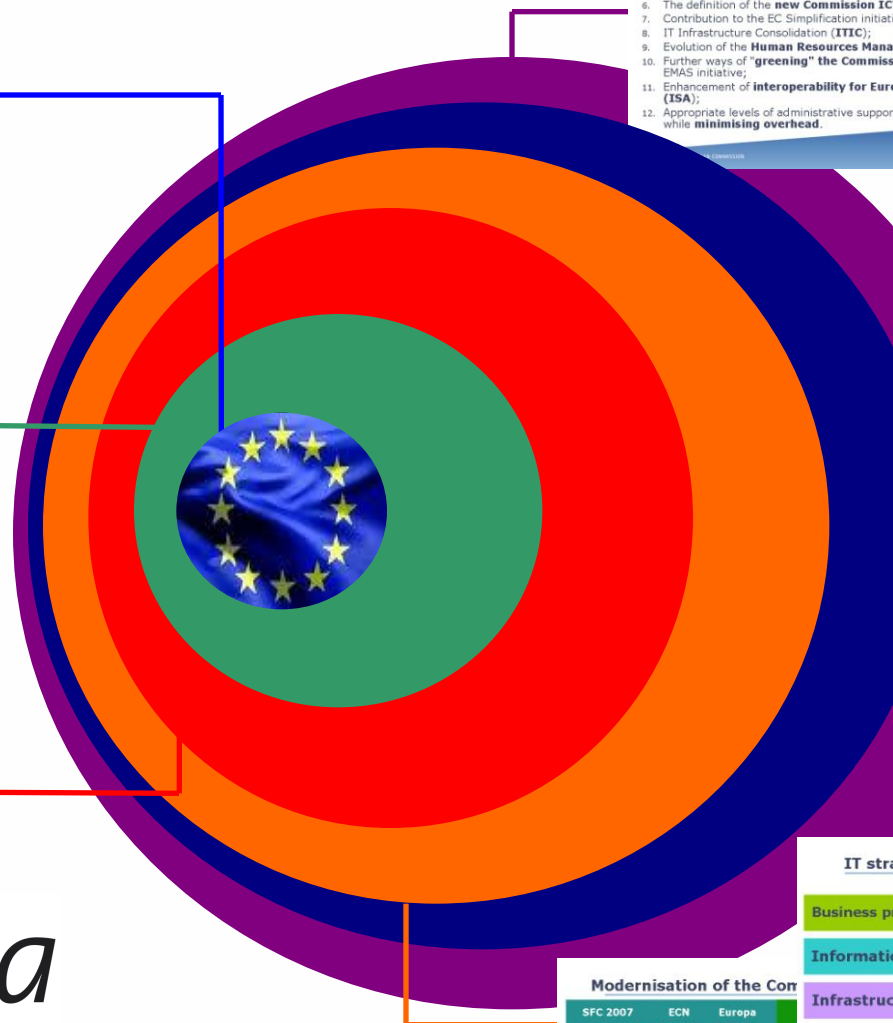

DIGIT MP 2010 : PRIORITIES

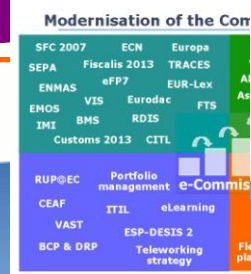
1. Security and Business Continuity for IT mission critical services;

4. Evolution of the Office Automation infrastructure including mobility services and email;
5. Evolution towards a better more resilient advanced IT and Communication Infrastructure and services;
6. The definition of the new Commission ICT strategy 2011-2015;
7. Contribution to the EC Simplification initiative (Corporate Portal);
8. IT Infrastructure Consolidation (ITIC);
9. Evolution of the Human Resources Management systems;
10. Further ways of "greening" the Commission's ICT in line with the EMAS initiative;
11. Enhancement of Interoperability for European Public services (ISA);

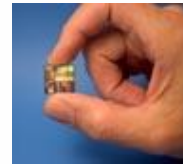
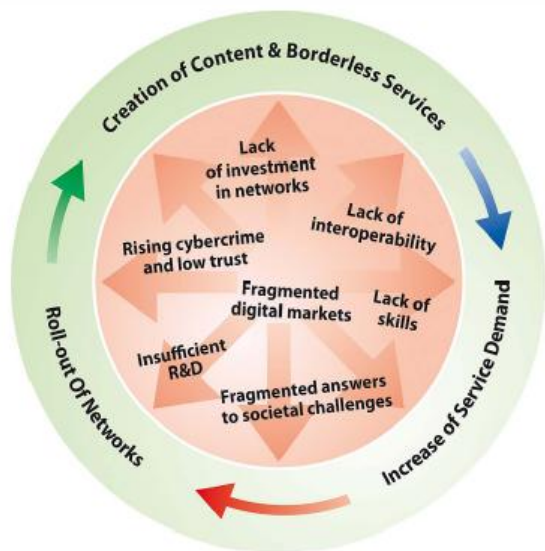

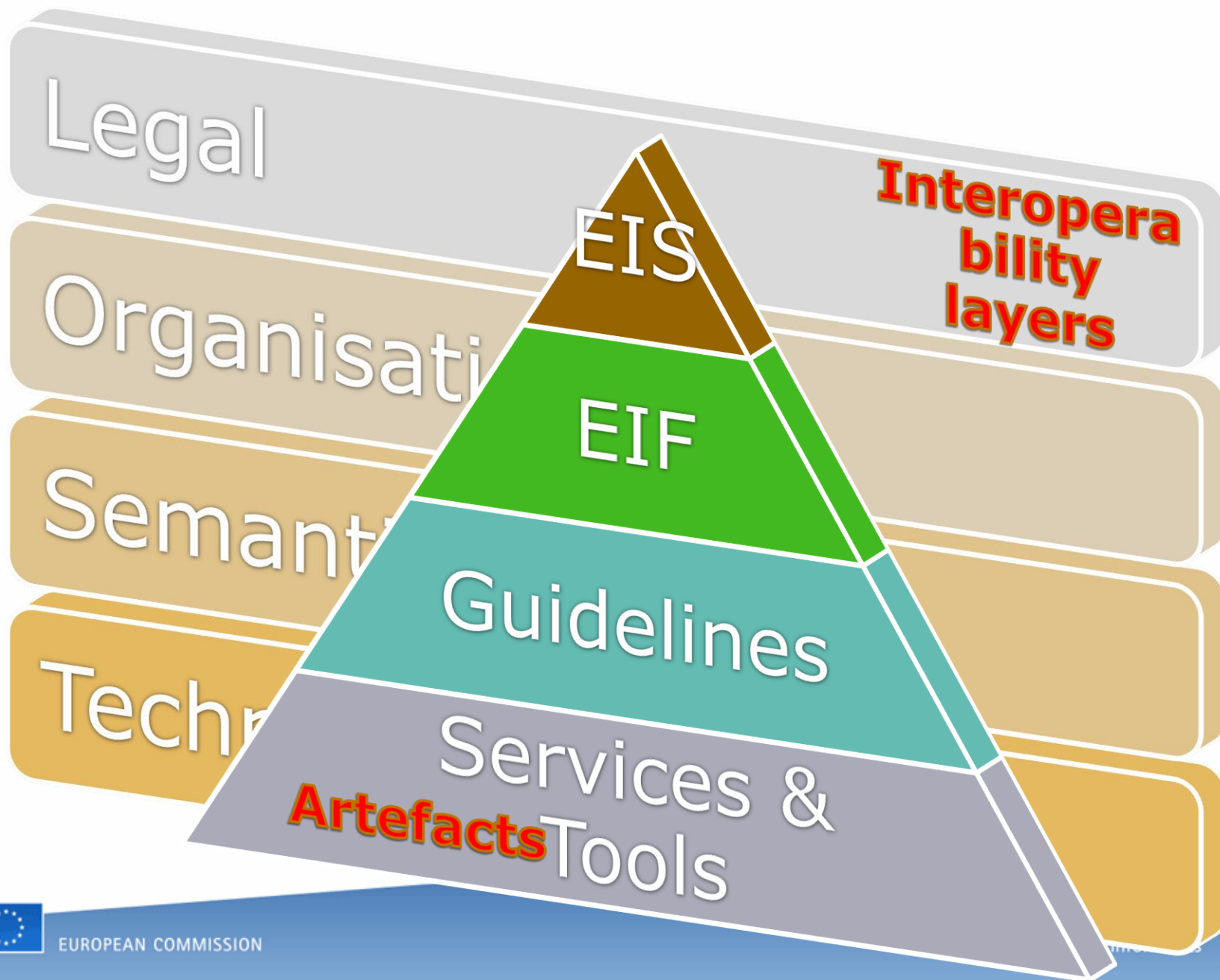
