eP Research: DEMO-net


- DEMO-net is a Network of Excellence, funded by the EC
- Coordinator is the University of Leeds, Uni of Macedonia is partner
- It brings together a number of European organisations and researchers
- The aim of an NoE is to "to strengthen scientific and technological excellence on a particular research topic by integrating at European level the critical mass of resources and expertise needed to provide European leadership and to be a world force in that topic"

Main Results so far

- Research to understand eParticipation, e.g.:
 - eP areas, tools, technologies, socio-technical issues etc.
 - eP tools and their use in eP; review of eP research projects
 - eP research methods
- Contribution towards building an eP community, e.g.:
 - The DEMO-net members are now more than 130
 - A Community of Practice has been established. It includes four Special Interest Groups (SIGs) in Industry, Government executives, politicians, NGOs.
- Training of young researchers and other stakeholders, e.g.:
 - Two PhD colloquiums organised within DEXA/EGOV conference
 - Training material is under preparation; it will be soon available through an online eLearning System (based on moodle)
- The website www.demonet.org is a valuable resource for researchers (see Researchers Corner) and other stakeholders alike
- Monthly and 6-monthly newsletter with all eP events (subscribe now!)
