

### Many different pieces


- Web 2.0

### Phase One – Remote Log-in – One-to-One






### Phase One – E-mail – One-to-One







### Phase Two – Web – One-to-Many




#### **Phase Three – Napster – Many-to-Many**








## Critical technology choices


