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




# Objective of the EU Cloud Strategy

Europe [...] should develop an EU-wide strategy on 'cloud computing' notably for government and science." (EDA)

Enabling and facilitating <u>faster adoption</u> of cloud computing, throughout <u>all sectors</u> of the economy to help <u>cut ICT costs</u> and <u>boost productivity</u>, <u>growth and jobs</u>

## Opportunities

<u>Supply side:</u> for telcos, equipment, services providers

<u>Demand side:</u> Productivity potential for all; quicker and less risky professional IT for new companies (e.g. start-ups)





### Key Action 1: Cutting through the Jungle of Standards

- ETSI (European Telecoms Standards Institute) to coordinate stakeholders & <u>identify necessary standards</u> (e.g. for security and interoperability)
- Recognize ICT technical specifications for data protection
- ENISA & others to assist development of EU-wide voluntary certification schemes
- ➤ Agree with industry harmonised metrics for energy consumption & carbon emissions of cloud services





### Key action 2: Safe and Fair Contract Terms

- Develop with stakeholders <u>model terms</u> for cloud computing <u>service level agreements</u> for professional cloud users
- ➤ European <u>model contract terms and conditions</u> pursuant to Common European Sales Law; expert group for cloud-related issues beyond the CSL
- Review standard contractual clauses & binding corporate rules for international data transfers by cloud providers
- ➤ Work with industry towards a <u>code of conduct for cloud</u> <u>providers</u> for Article 29 Working Party to endorse





### Key Action 3: European Cloud Partnership

- > What:
  - Identify <u>common requirements</u> for public sector cloud use
  - Towards common & joint public procurement of cloud services
  - > Shape the market to benefit private use
- ➤ How:
  - Steering Board: industry and MS
  - Pre-Commercial Procurement Action with MS (FP7, EUR 10m call published), with industry input
  - ➤ Umbrella for MS cloud activities





#### Other Actions

Focus <u>Future European Research Funding</u> Horizon 2020 <u>support</u>

<u>Cloud support</u> for Connecting Europe Facility (<u>CEF</u>)

Cloud in <u>International Dialogue</u> and freetrade negotiations





## **European Cloud Communication: Conclusion**

- Closed models and <u>vendor lock-in</u> are a <u>danger</u> for Cloud model <u>take-up</u>
- Appropriate <u>standards and certification</u> schemes need to be identified
- The <u>Public sector</u> has an important <u>role</u> for the shaping of the <u>Cloud computing</u> <u>market</u>
