## Introduction - Lombardy at-a-glance

**Lombardy** Region

- The most populated Italian region (~10 millions)
- The highest number of municipalities (1.546)
- > 12 provinces, with the biggest ones (Milan)
- The third Italian Region for geographical extension (~23.000 km²)
- ➤ The real regional Gross Domestic Product (GDP) is the 20,9% of the Italian GDP
- The regional GDP is 126,1 vs Italian value of 100

- Lombardia Region (only headquarter) → 320 mln €/year
- Health sector : 50 authorities → 2.600 mln € /year
- Regional sector : 70 authorities → 64 mln € /year
- Local Entities: 1600 authorities → 1.500 mln € /year
- > Total amount: over 4.500 mln € (except works)






## **eProcurement and Open Government**

### **Transparency and Open Data – Available datasets**

- At present, in Italy there more than 7.900 datasets from Public Administration; all of them are available in the open data format
- Lombardy Region is at the second position (603 datasets)



Dataset availability vs channel















### The Open Data portal

- It is possible to download data regarding eTenders launched on SINTEL



## **Using Open Data for iOS/Android Apps**

Lombardy Region promoted and financed the development of iOS/Android APPS based on the available open data

The app allows an offline consultation of eTenders (Sintel); business operators can monitor — even lacking an internet connection — all the information concerning the tenders in which they're interested in.

It is possible to save **favorites** and **reminders** (tenders deadlines).



#### What else can be done?

**Laws / Regulation**

**Change management** 

- Documentation sharing mandatory
- Monitoring the open data availability
- Integration
- Common standards
- Improve functionalities to manage nondiscretional evaluation criteria
- Integration between platforms, in particular regional vs national
- Better use of Business Intelligence
- Both on the supplier and government entities side
- Being "open" and "transparent" is first of all a matter of culture



## eTendering performance impacts

+ 62% online sharing of tender documents

Adoption of standards (for documents and processes)

Easier to spread competencies and best practices

- 30% procedure duration

- 6 FTE employed per tender

EFFICIENCY

+ 7% average savings increase

+ 250 % suppliers invited to tenders



- 72% paper per tender (1 saved tree every 24 eTenders)

+ 60% quantity and timeliness of information
