1. Independent Model

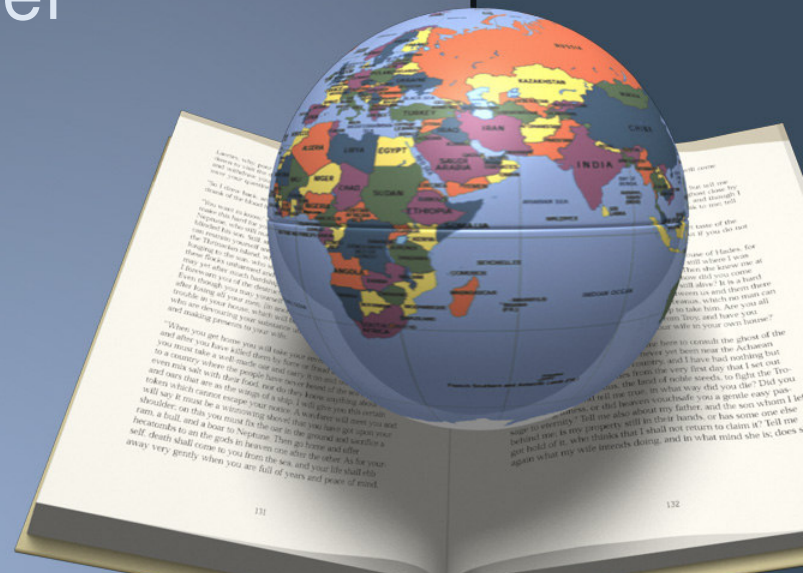
2. Federated Model

3. Centralized Model



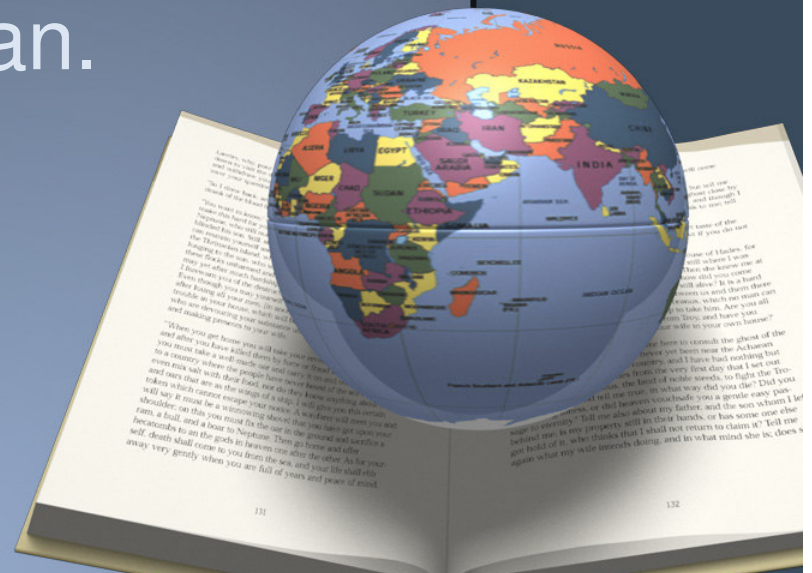
Reporting Structures....

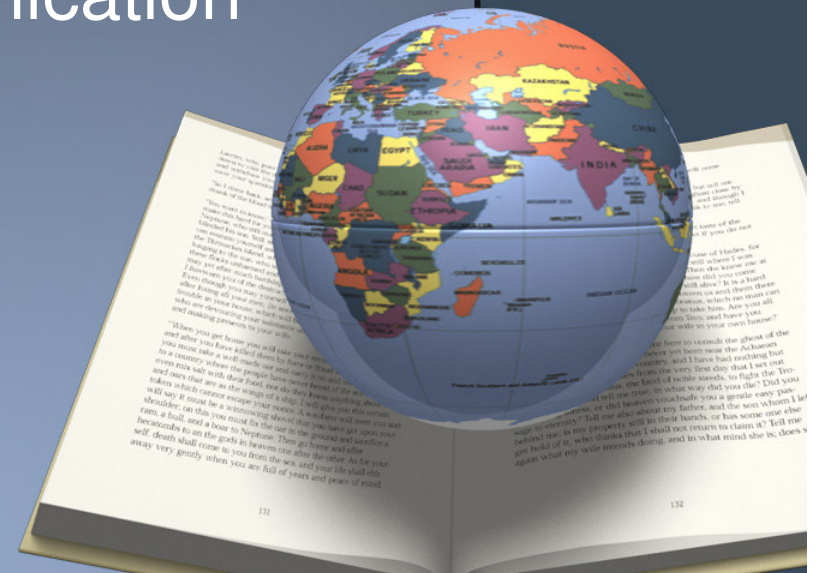

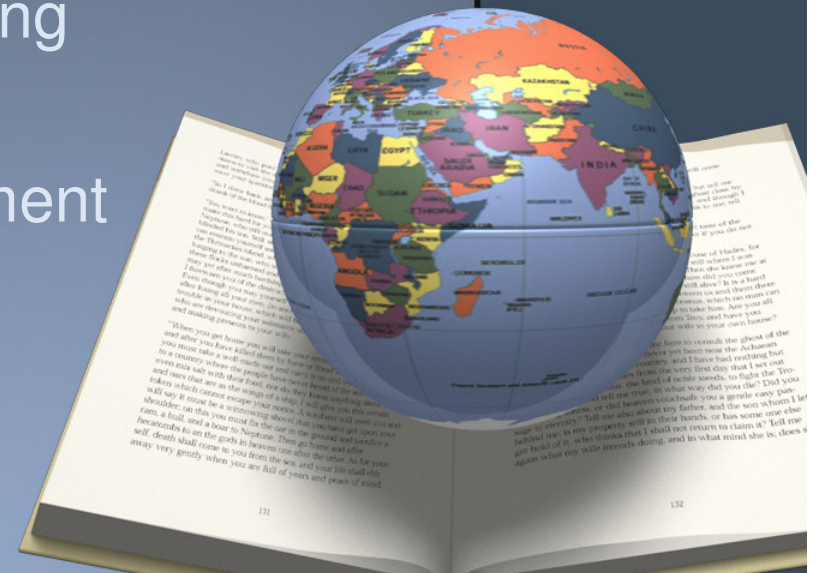

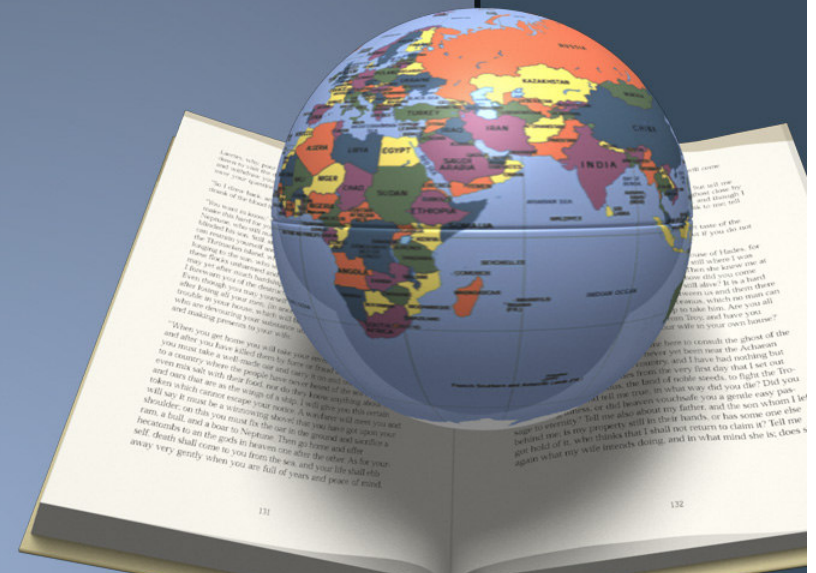
