





Case Abstract

In May 2006 the municipal public library of Avelgem (Belgium) was transformed into a self-service library ready for the future. In this project RFID technology has been linked to the use of the electronic identity card (eID) in a unique combination. The project has already been awarded the Belgian eGovernment Award 2006 as a "small but smart project: a clear scope, manageable (both as regards means and as regards duration), based on a long-term vision, with political support and guidance and with a visible and definite customer orientation and an unmistakable impact on the organisation itself".

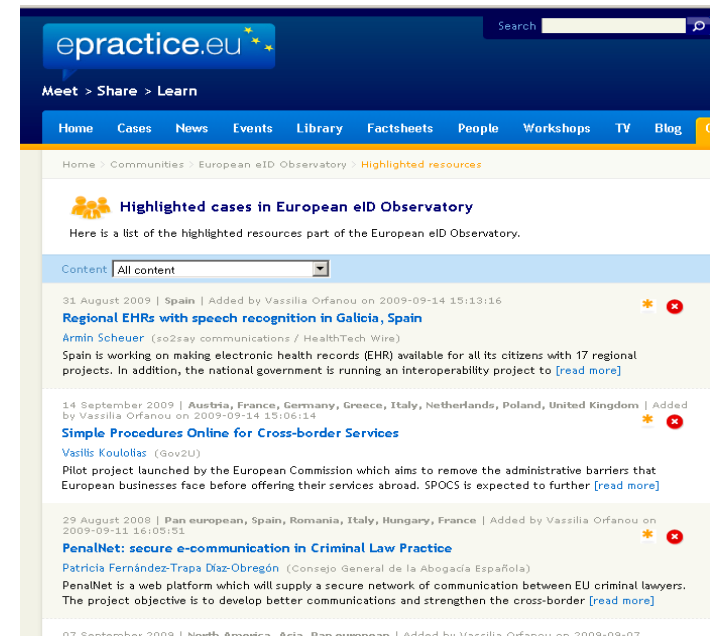


