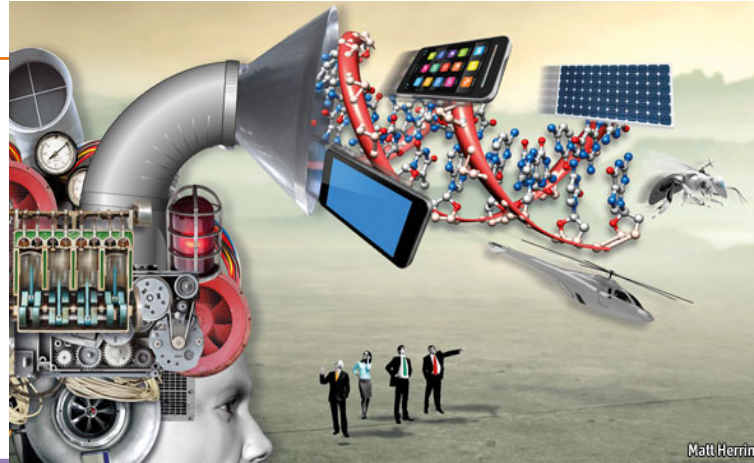

...Dismal results

- Productivity at micro level translates into Zero or little growth at macro level
- Democracy is not affected where it exists, does not expand elsewhere
- Education remains mostly unscathed
- Development in emerging economies is driven by:
 - Catch-up processes
 - Commodities
- Income distribution hollowed out

Is the linkage between innovation and social progress broken?



A few assumptions to steer the connected age...and what it takes

- Make productivity happen: redesign business processes
- Re-orient the economic system towards production: downsize the financial industry (partially under way)
- ***Fix society and income distribution: are radical approaches required?***
