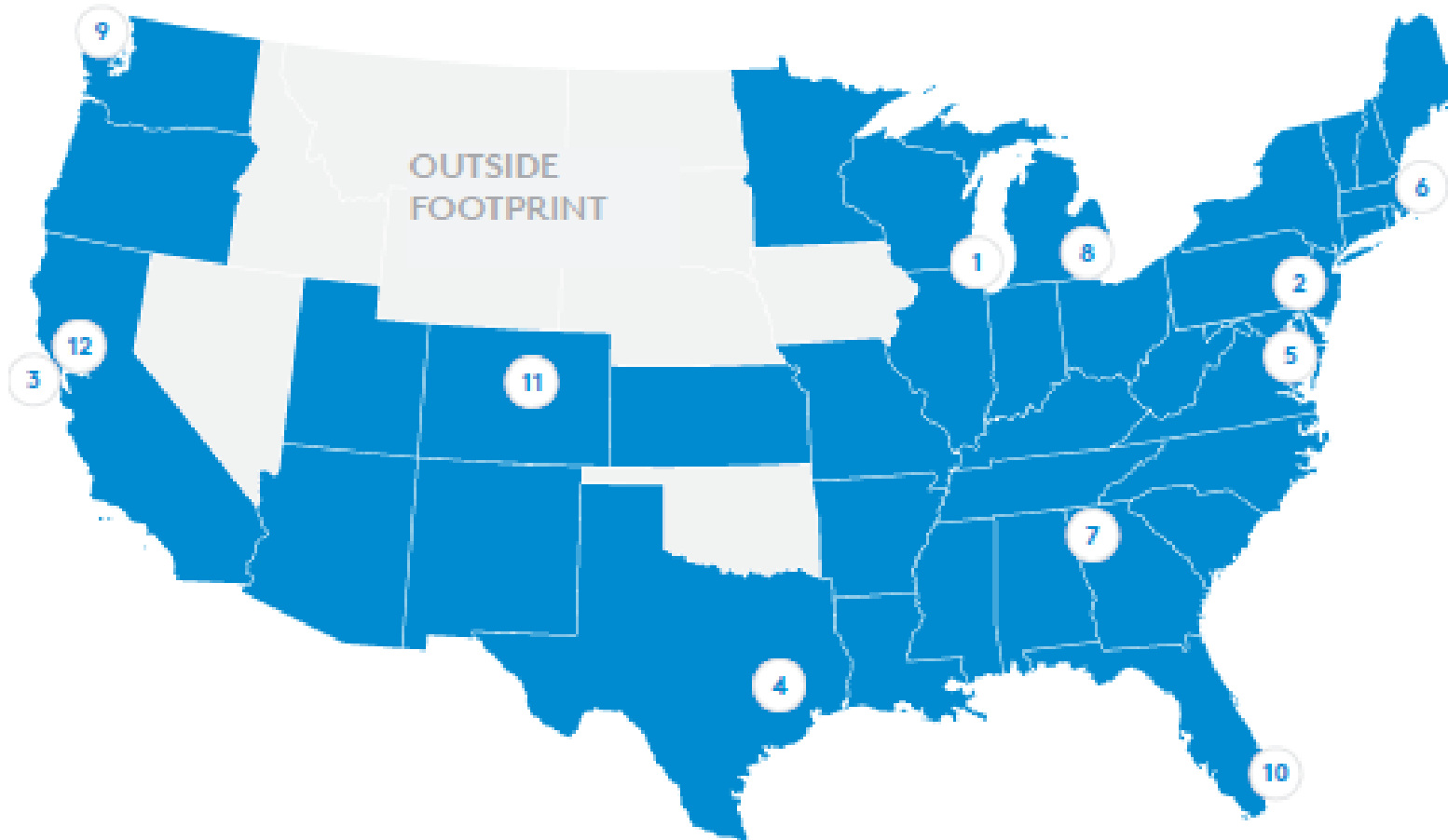




The nation's largest provider of gigabit internet

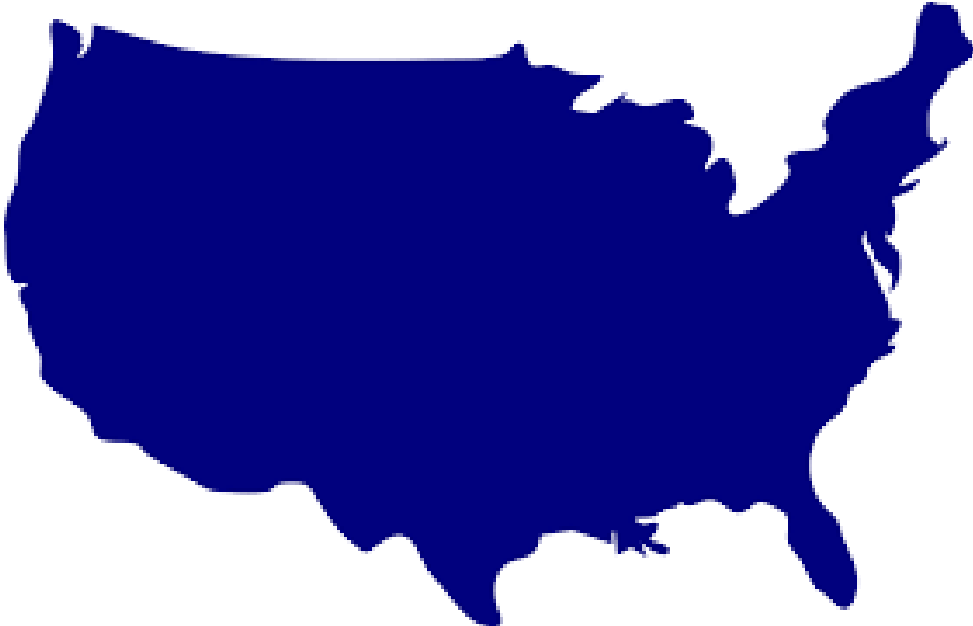

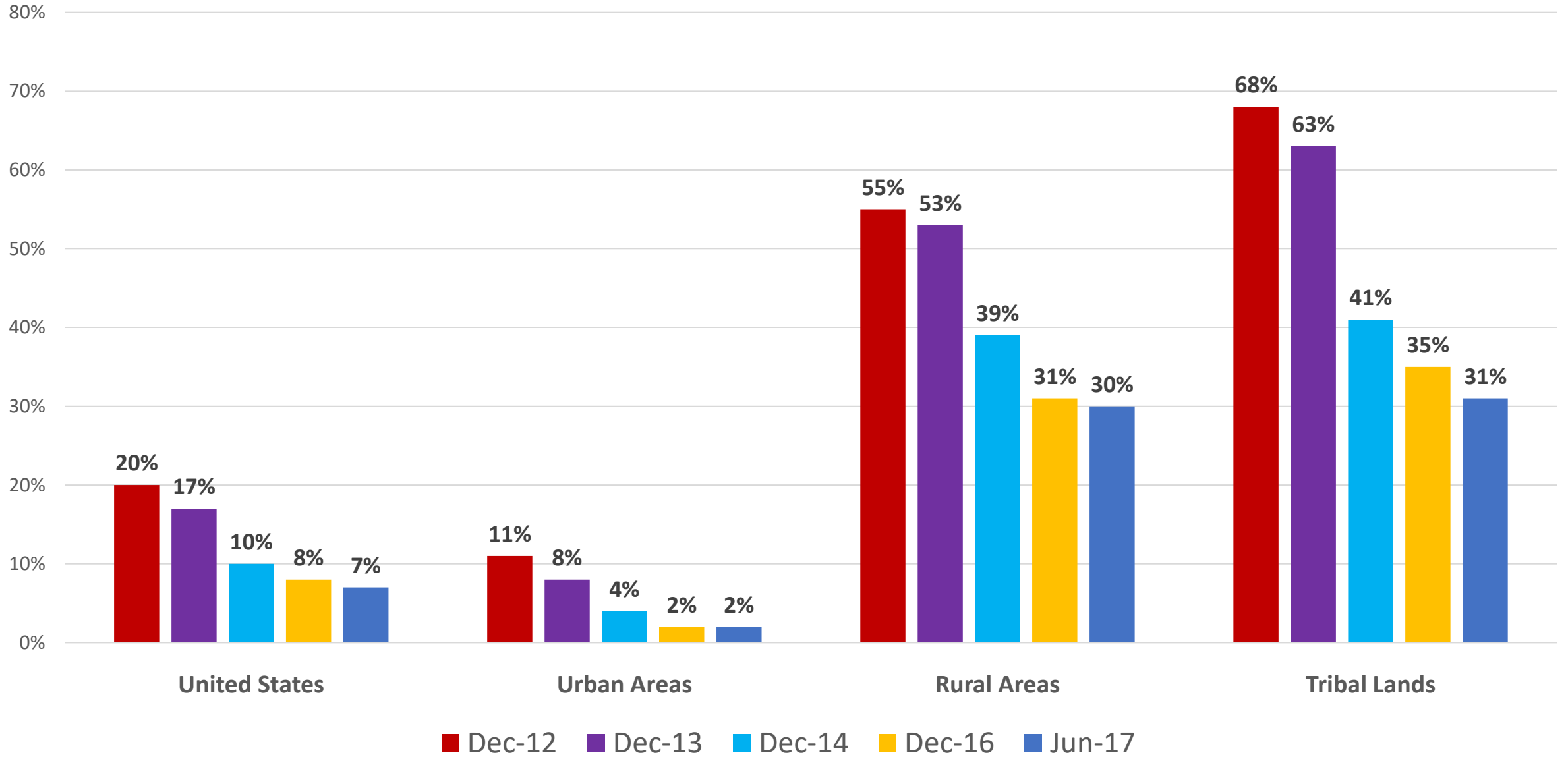

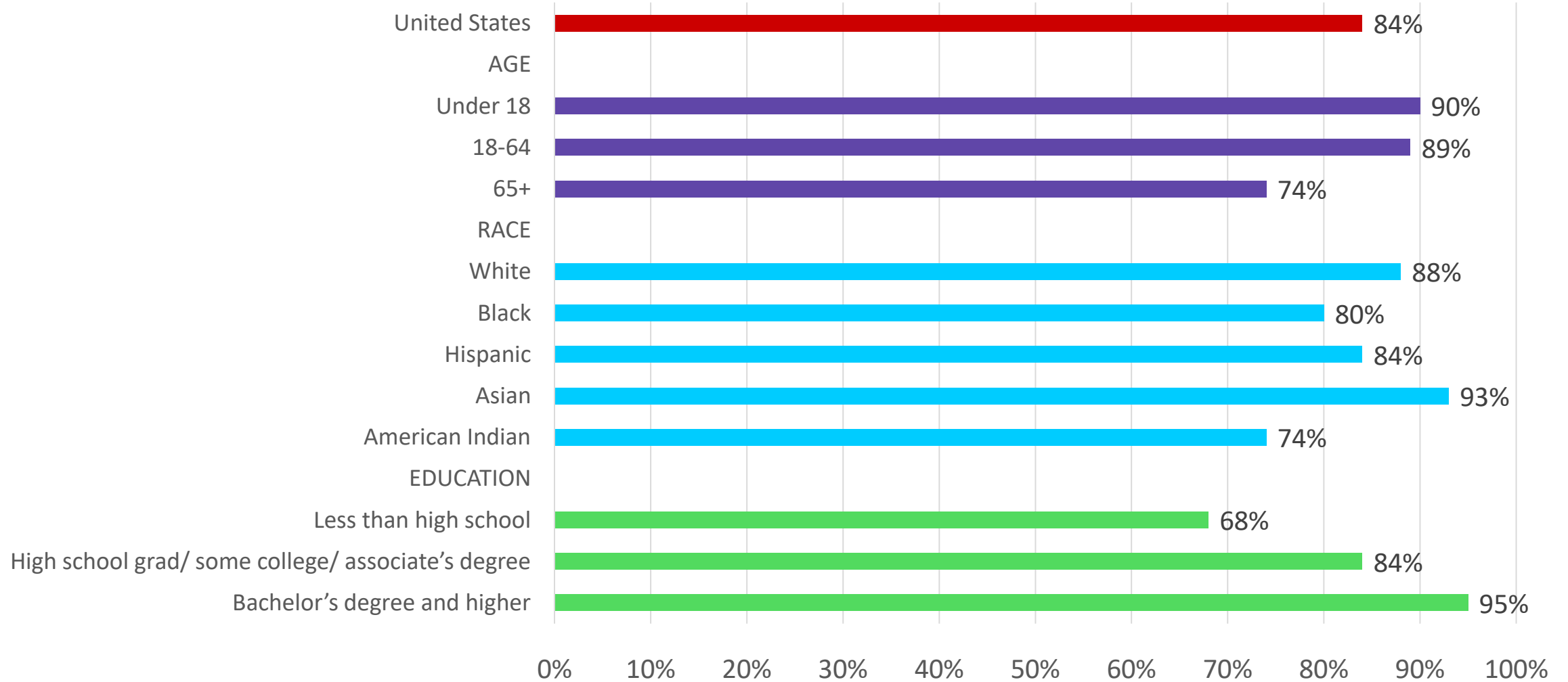

Population Share Without Access to 25/3 Mbps (Fixed Terrestrial)

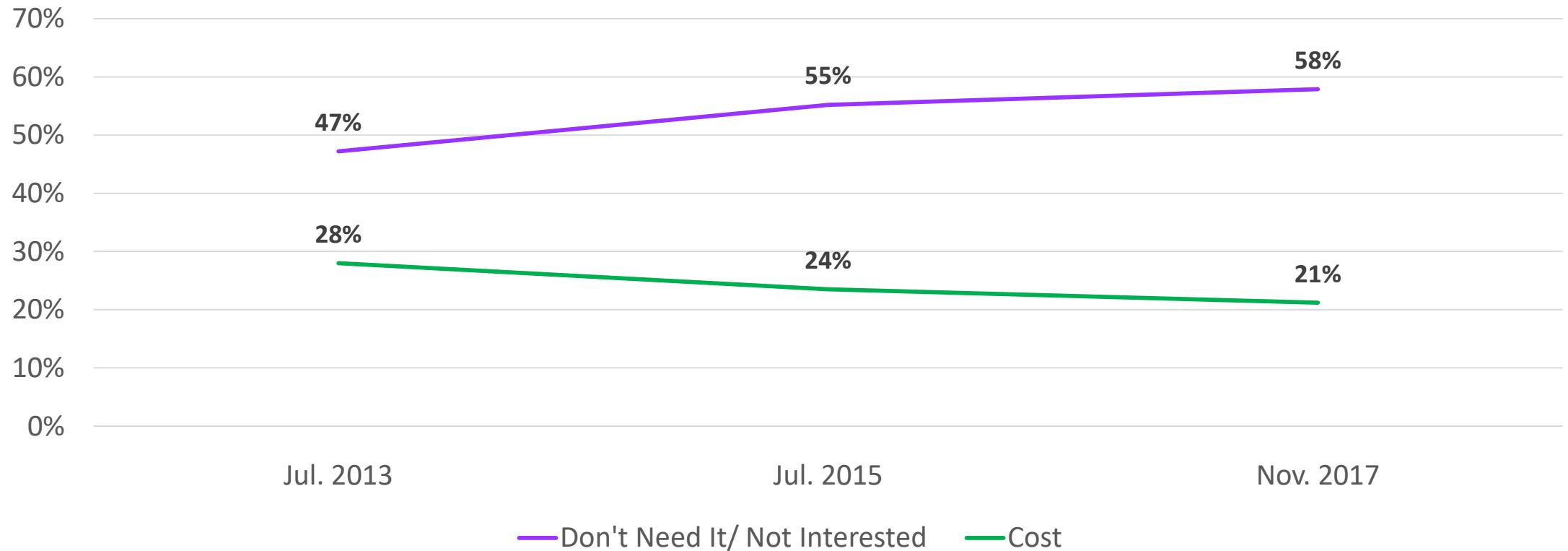


Broadband Adoption Rates (as of 2017)
