# ICT background in Africa

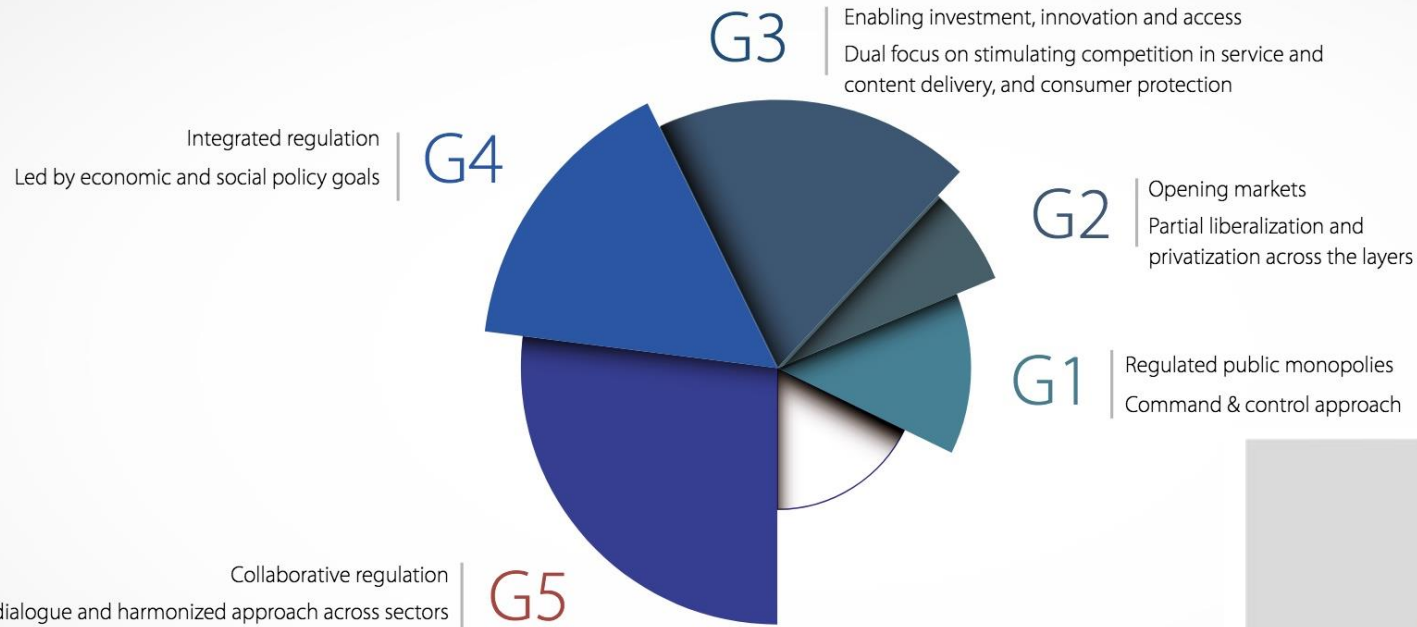
- Mobile penetration in SSA 444 million unique subscribers and 747 million SIM cards.
- Internet penetration - 36.2% - closer to
- Mobile broadband penetration – 38%
- Fixed broadband penetration – 1.9% -

# Policy and Regulatory Challenges of access to broadband

- Gap between supply and demand –fiber cable accessible to over 40 percent of the population
- Policies that promote competition, open access, infrastructure sharing and private investment as well as public and private partnership did not advance with the market and users' needs,
- **Cross-border policy harmonization**

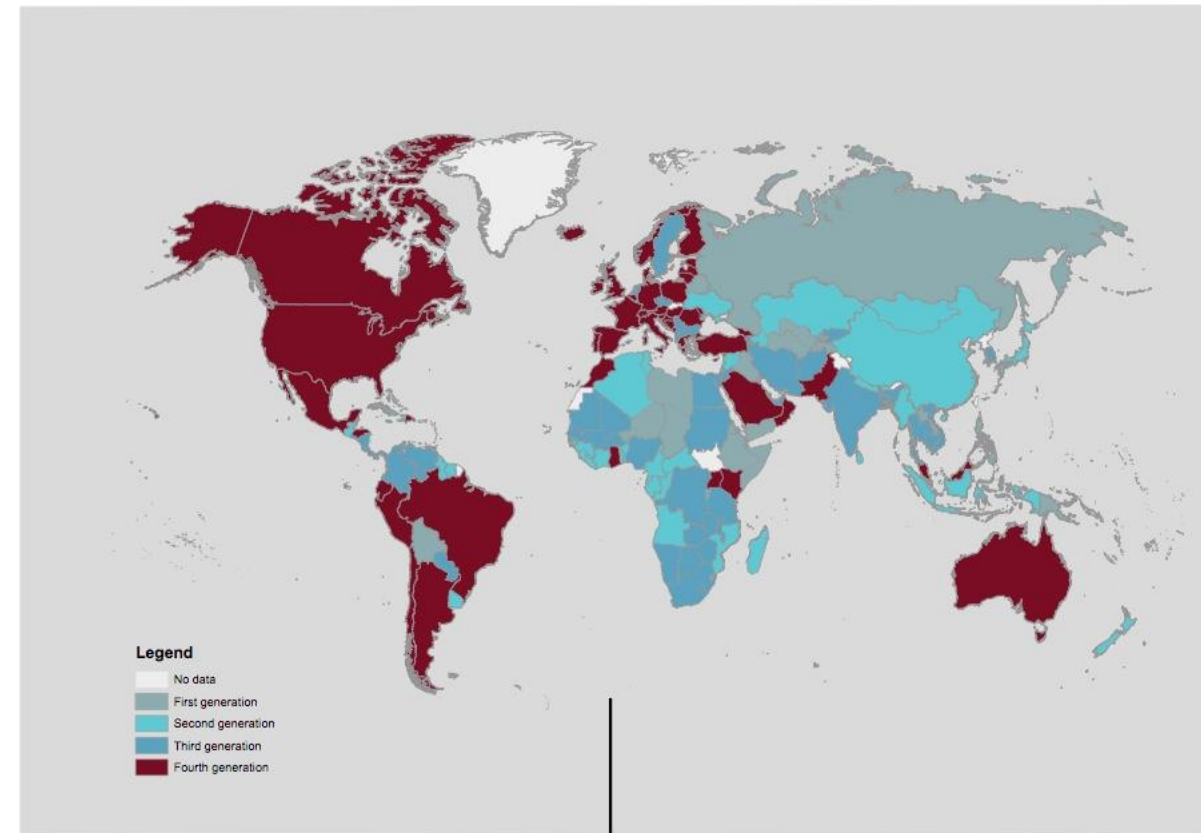
