

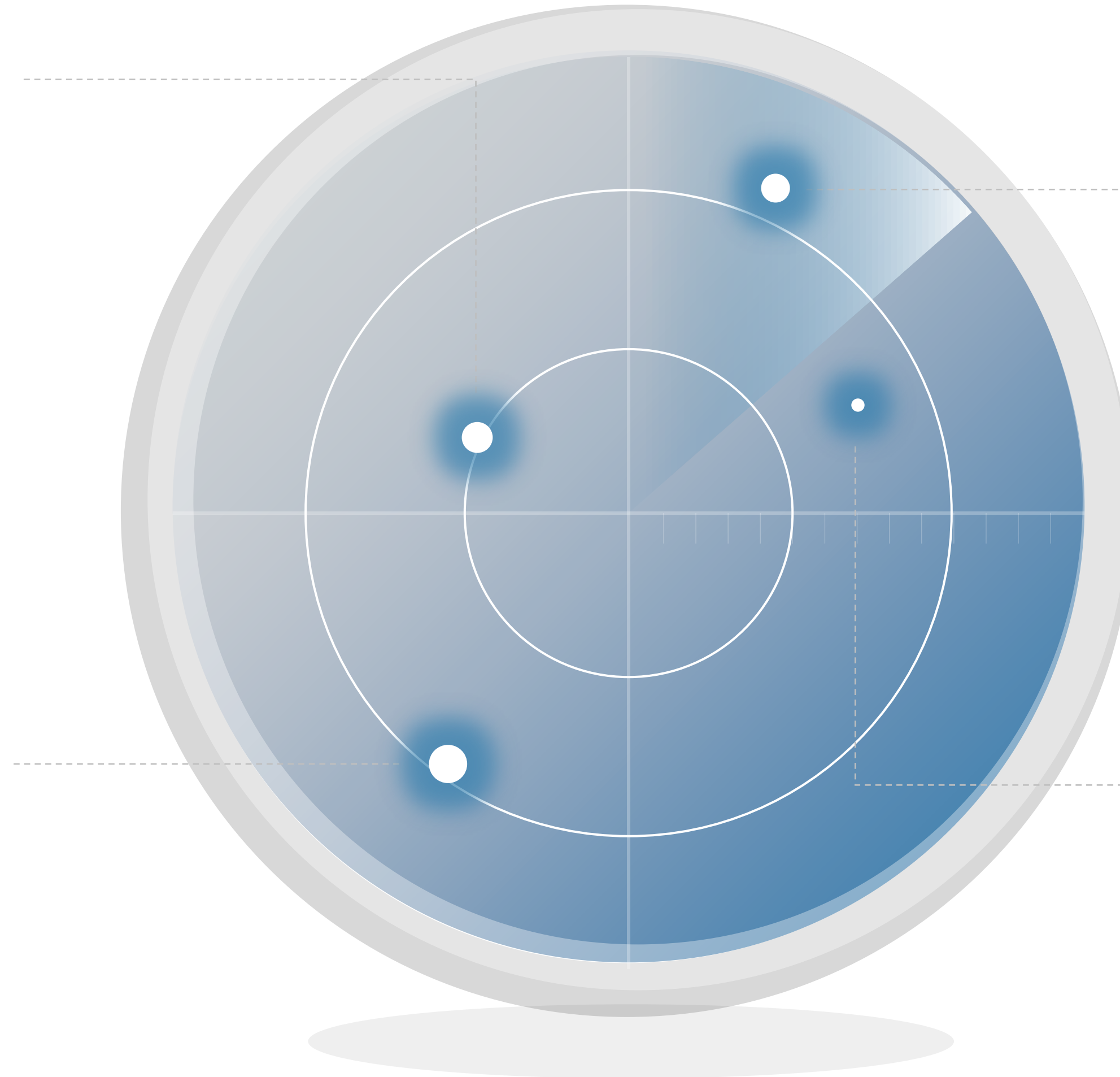

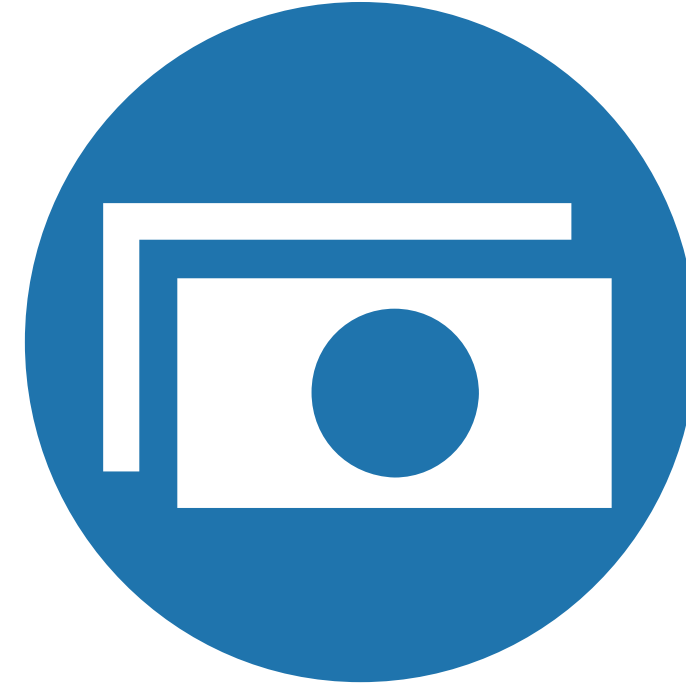

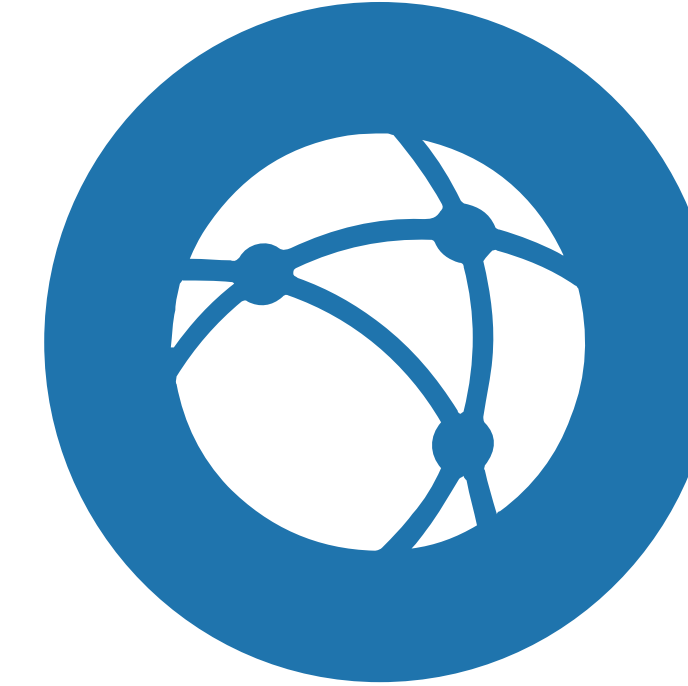
Accuracy

Decreased accuracy and quality of data



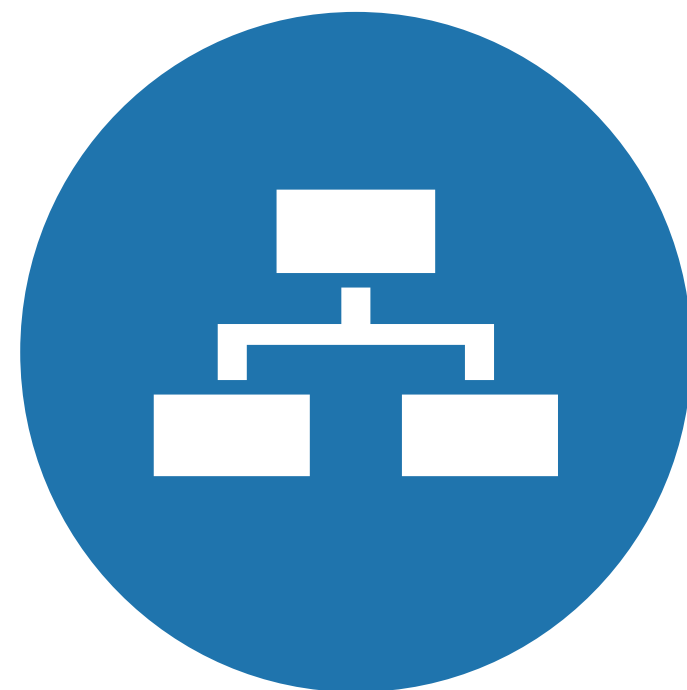
Cost

RDM/ MDM

Development of Centralized Reference Data and Master Data Models for Abu Dhabi Government. Design Meta Data Model that can be adopted by ADGEs as a standard.

Development of a comprehensive Data Strategy Communication Plan to ensure the awareness of all Stake holders of the strategy and the objectives.
