

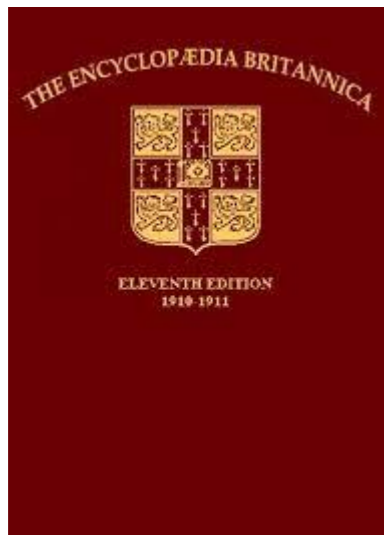
ETHICS AND REGULATION FOR AI

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Ethics and law: twins? Warring brothers? Family?



Ethics: the discipline concerned with what is morally **good and bad** and morally **right and wrong**.

Ethics deals with such questions at all levels. Its subject consists of the fundamental issues of practical decision making, and its major concerns include the nature of **ultimate value** and the standards by which human actions can be judged right or wrong.

Law: enforceable and punishable : sanctions and damages

Definition of ethics by UNESCO

AI ethics:

A systematic normative reflection, based on a **holistic**, comprehensive, **multicultural** and **evolving** framework of interdependent **values, principles and actions** that can guide societies in dealing responsibly with the known and unknown impacts of AI technologies on human beings, societies and the environment and ecosystems, and offers them a basis to accept or reject AI technologies.

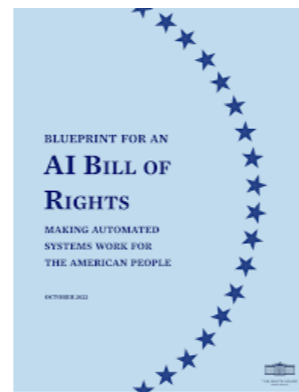
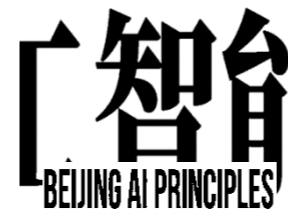
