








Ethics and law: twins? Warring brothers? Family?



Ethics: the discipline concerned with what is morally good and bad and morally right and wrong.

Ethics deals with such questions at all levels. Its subject consists of the fundamental issues of practical decision making, and its major concerns include the nature of **ultimate value** and the standards by which human actions can be judged right or wrong.

Law: enforceable and punishable : sanctions and damages













Definition of ethics by UNESCO

Al ethics:

A systematic normative reflection, based on a **holistic**, comprehensive, **multicultural** and **evolving** framework of interdependent **values**, **principles and actions** that can guide societies in dealing responsibly with the known and unknown impacts of Al technologies on human beings, societies and the environment and ecosystems, and offers them a basis to accept or reject Al technologies.




